**SIDE 2:** Teach us to listen for you in every corner of our lives and to await your messengers in the most unexpected situations and conditions.

**SIDE 1:** Keep nudging us to move toward growth when our resistance holds us back. When we question the impracticality or the seeming impossibility of these nudges, give us wisdom and courage to let go of what restrains us.

**SIDE 2:** Still and quiet our souls. May we hear the whisper of your divine call, asking us each day to accept the treasure of your life within us.

**SIDE 1:** May the music of Mary's own trustful response sing in our spirits. Gift us with the ability to move forward into the unknown, confident that you will guide and direct us.

**ALL:** Mary, thank you for your courageous "yes". Like you, we are not alone in the call to face an unknown future. May we trust that the Holy One will shelter us and accompany us on our spiritual journey. May the spirit of your child, Jesus, live on in us. May we, too, be people of great love, carrying the Divine Presence in the womb of our hearts.
